Fort St John RCMP make arrest day after residential break and enter



On February 7, 2023, the Fort St John RCMP received a report of a residential break and enter in the Charlie Lake area, where a pistol, two shotguns and a rifle had been stolen along with a video gaming console.

During the investigation, front-line RCMP officers received information that the items were believed to be at a Fort St John residence located on the 9200 block of 93rd Ave, and obtained a search warrant for the residence.

On February 8, 2023, Fort St John front-line RCMP police officers along with Drug Unit plain clothes officers located and arrested the property owner of the residence.

The search warrant was subsequently executed on the residence with two shotguns and the video gaming console being recovered by police. Police also seized a significant amount of a what is believed to be illicit drugs.

As a result of the investigation, Christopher Darryl Munch was arrested and is currently facing charges of:

- Break and Enter to Steal a Firearm,
- Break and Enter to Commit Theft,
- Careless Use of a Firearm,
- Possession of a Prohibited Firearm with Ammunition,
- Possession Contrary to Order,
- Possession of Property Obtained by Crime,
- Breach of Probation Order.

At the time of the arrest, Munch was prohibited from possessing any firearms. Munch was held for court where he was remanded into custody until February 13, 2023 and again until February 15, 2023.

The Fort St John RCMP continue to investigate and are asking anyone who has information in this matter to contact the Fort St John RCMP.

Ambulance paramedics, dispatchers ratify agreement under Shared Recovery Mandate



The Health Employers Association of BC and the members of the Ambulance Paramedics and Dispatchers Bargaining Association have ratified an agreement under the Shared Recovery Mandate.

The agreement covers approximately 5,000 paramedics and ambulance dispatchers in British Columbia. The Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE) Local 873 represents the employees in the ambulance service. Paramedics and ambulance dispatchers are employees of BC Emergency Health Services (BCEHS), which is part of Provincial Health Services Authority (PHSA).

Key priorities of the 2022 mandate include:

- protecting the services that people in British Columbia depend on;
- improving health care and preparing for future needs and challenges; and
- supporting a strong economic recovery that includes everyone in B.C.

Negotiations are focused on providing a fair and reasonable offer to public-sector workers that includes significant inflation protection, while ensuring that government has the resources to continue to invest in building a stronger province for everyone.

The ratified agreement includes:

- three-year term - April 1, 2022, to March 31, 2025
- general wage increases:
- Year 1 – a flat increase of \$0.25 per hour, which provides a greater percentage increase for lower-paid employees, plus an increase of 3.24%
- Year 2 – 5.5% plus a potential cost-of-living adjustment to a max of 6.75%
- Year 3 – 2% plus a potential cost-of-living adjustment to a maximum of 3%
- A negotiable flexibility allocation for as much as 0.25% in years 1 and 2 to support mutually beneficial outcomes for both parties.

Other achievements in this round of negotiations included increases to improve on-call coverage and response times in rural and remote communities, as well as provisions on Indigenous-specific anti-racism initiatives, including paid leave to support Indigenous employees in connecting with cultural and spiritual beliefs. In addition, the parties agreed to diversity, equity and inclusion initiatives, including a provincial working group and the removal of gender-normative uniform rules.

Approximately 288,000 provincial public-sector employees are covered by tentative or ratified agreements reached under B.C.'s Shared Recovery Mandate.

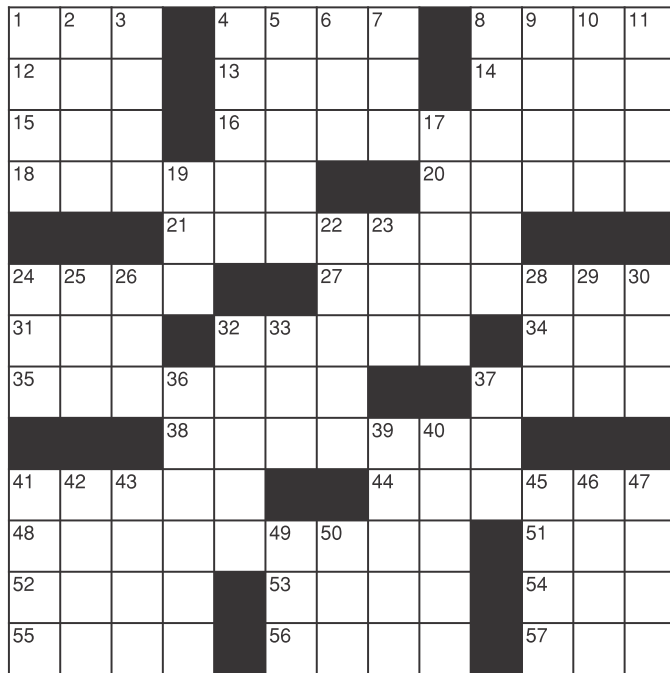

Pernil Mac and Cheese

Pernil, a Puerto Rican-style roast pork shoulder, is flavoured with garlic, oregano, and sazón, a seasoning blend that includes coriander and annatto. Serve this garlicky pernil on top of a rich and creamy mac and cheese. Rubbing the seasoned garlic paste into the pork and letting it rest allows the flavours to penetrate deeply into the thick roast.

Ingredients

Pernil

- 1 ¼ cups peeled garlic cloves (from about 4 garlic heads)
- 3 tablespoons dried oregano
- 3 tablespoons white vinegar
- 2 tablespoons coarse kosher salt (such as Morton's)
- 1 tablespoon plus 1 ½ teaspoons sazón with coriander and annatto (such as Badia)
- 1 tablespoon adobo all-purpose seasoning powder with pepper
- 1 (7- to 9 pound) bone-in, skin-on pork shoulder

Mac and Cheese

- 3 quarts water
- 1 tablespoon plus 2 teaspoons coarse kosher salt (such as Morton's), divided
- 1 pound uncooked elbow macaroni
- 4 large eggs
- 2 cups heavy cream
- 1 teaspoon seasoned salt (such as Lawry's)
- 1 teaspoon black pepper
- 1 ½ pounds sharp cheddar cheese, shredded (about 6 cups), divided
- Cooking spray



Directions

Make the pernil:

1. Process garlic, oregano, vinegar, salt, sazón, and adobo seasoning in a food processor until mixture forms a paste, about 45 seconds, stopping occasionally to scrape down sides of bowl. Alternatively, crush mixture using a mortar and pestle to form a paste.
2. Using a sharp knife, score pork skin and fat cap about ¼ to ½ inch deep in a diamond pattern, spacing cuts 1 ¼ inches apart. Cut 8 (2 ½-inch-deep) slits into bottom and sides of pork. Rub garlic paste over roast, pushing into the slits and scores in fat cap. Place seasoned pork on a rimmed baking sheet; cover tightly with plastic wrap, and refrigerate 4 to 12 hours.
3. Preheat oven to 350°F with rack in lower third position. Unwrap pork shoulder. Place pork, skin side up, in a medium-size roasting pan; let rest at room temperature while oven preheats. Roast pork, uncovered, in preheated oven until a thermometer inserted in thickest portion of meat registers 200°F, 5 to 7 hours, tenting with aluminum foil after 1 hour and 45 minutes if needed to prevent burning. After about 2 hours of roasting, begin basting pork with pan drippings every hour. Transfer cooked pernil to a cutting board, and let rest 30 minutes. Reserve drippings in pan. Do not turn oven off. Carefully position oven rack in middle of oven.

While pork roasts, make the mac and cheese:

1. Bring 3 quarts water to a boil in a large pot over medium-high. Stir in 1 tablespoon kosher salt. Add pasta, and cook according to package directions until al dente. Drain pasta, and rinse well under cold water. Whisk eggs vigorously in a large bowl until frothy, about 1 minute. Whisk in cream, seasoned salt, black pepper, and remaining 2 teaspoons kosher salt. Stir in 5 cups cheese until well combined. Gently fold in cooked pasta. Spoon mixture into a 13- x 9-inch baking dish lightly coated with cooking spray. Sprinkle evenly with remaining 1 cup cheese. Cover and refrigerate unbaked mac and cheese until pork has finished roasting.
2. While pernil rests, uncover mac and cheese. Place on middle rack in oven; bake at 350°F until light golden brown on top, about 45 minutes. During final 15 minutes of baking mac and cheese, remove skin from pernil, and finely chop. Shred meat into bite-size pieces. Transfer shredded meat and chopped skin to a large bowl; toss to combine. Discard pork bone, or reserve for stock. Pour pan drippings into a fat separator or a measuring cup; skim and discard fat. Season pernil to taste with skimmed pan drippings. Divide mac and cheese among bowls; top with pernil.
