Groundhog Day 2023 - Is it Spring Yet??

Feb 2nd was Groundhog Day here in Canada and the US. Groundhog Day is a popular North American tradition observed in the United States and Canada on February 2. It comes from the Pennsylvania Dutch superstition that if a groundhog emerges from its burrows on this day and sees its shadow due to clear weather, it will retreat to its den and winter will go on for six more weeks; if it does not see its shadow because of cloudiness, spring will arrive early.

Perhaps one of the most famous groundhogs, Punxatawney Phil, who draws a crowd of thousands each year and was a central character in a very funny movie starring Bill Murray, predicts that another 6 weeks of winter is in its way. But Phil isn't the only furry 4-legged meteorological mammal to make predictions of the coming spring.

Here is a what a couple of the more famous buck-toothed winter hibernators predicted -

SHUBENACADIE SAM

Shubenacadie Sam emerged from her burrow Thursday and unfortunately saw her shadow. She made her annual prediction just after 8 a.m. at Shubenacadie Wildlife Park in Shubenacadie, N.S.



The Twitter account for Sam alerted the public to her prediction and warned not to put away hats or mitts just yet.

WIARTON WILLIE

In a dramatic twist, Wiarton Willie challenged Sam's forecast by predicting an early spring. Willie, who lives in the South Bruce Peninsula in Ontario, emerged at 8:07 a.m. and did not see his shadow.

However, for more scientific-based advice - don't put your winter gear away quite yet. Phil tends to be right only about 39% of the time but predicting 6 more weeks of winter is a pretty safe bet. While The Weather Network has us enjoying spring-like temperatures for the next few days, things look quite a bit colder on the 14 day forecast. Listen to Sam, beach weather is still a ways away!

Creamy corn chowder

This hearty corn chowder is the perfect meal for a cold, wintery night. Indeed, it's a recipe you're sure to come back to again and again.

Start to finish: 45 minutes
Servings: 6

INGREDIENTS

- 6 slices bacon, chopped
- 1 leek (the white part only), finely chopped
- 1 large potato, diced
- 600 millilitres corn kernels (fresh, frozen or canned)
- 400 millilitres creamed corn
- 1-1/2 cups chicken or vegetable broth
- 1 cup milk
- 1/2 cup 15% cream
- 1 sprig fresh rosemary
- 1 bay leaf
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 4 chives, chopped

DIRECTIONS

1. In a large pot, cook the bacon. When it's almost done, add the leek. Continue to cook until the bacon is crispy and the leek is translucent. Drain the bacon grease.
2. Add the potato, corn, broth, milk, cream, rosemary and bay leaf and bring to a boil. Reduce the heat and simmer for 25 minutes or until the potato is soft.
3. Salt and pepper to taste.
4. Garnish with the chives, then serve and enjoy.

Conflict vs. bullying: what's the difference?



Conflict and bullying aren't the same things. One describes a healthy dialogue between two parties, while the other represents an intent to harm someone else. Learning to deal with conflict healthily can give you essential social skills. It can also

help you better identify bullying.

WHAT'S CONFLICT?

Conflict is a normal part of life and happens when two people respectfully disagree. The two parties have equal power in the relationship, and each has a chance to express their views.

Even though there may be negative emotions and hurtful words exchanged, both people are looking for a solution and don't want to harm each other. Each person takes responsibility for their actions and modifies their behaviour if they feel they've made the other person feel bad. Conflict can often lead to two people learning to solve problems and overcome challenges.

WHAT'S BULLYING?

Unlike conflict, the goal of bullying is to

hurt, harm, insult or humiliate another person and make them feel bad about themselves. The actions are unwanted and unwarranted, and the bullied person has little power to stop them. Bullying can result in physical and emotional harm.

Bullying happens when one person uses their power to control another. Power can mean the bully is bigger, stronger, older or more popular than the person they're bullying. Moreover, bullies aren't trying to resolve anything and show no remorse if they hurt someone else. There's no interest in a relationship with the other person.

This Pink Shirt Day, February 22, stand up to bullying when you see it. Don't be afraid to share your views and express your opinions constructively. Not all conflict is bad.
