


BCHP stops impaired driver for excessive speed

On July 24, 2022 as the month-long Summer CounterAttack Impaired Driving campaign draws to a close, BC Highway Patrol Dawson Creek stopped a vehicle for excessive speed on Highway 97 between Dawson Creek and Chetwynd.

The officer spoke with the lone driver of the vehicle and advised him he was traveling at 159 km/h in a posted 100 km/h zone. While speaking with the driver, the officer noted several symptoms of

impairment and had the driver submit to a mandatory roadside breath test. The result was a Fail.
