Canfor Continues Reduction

Supply chain issues have forced Canfor to continue a reduction in operating schedules at saw mills in Fort St. John and Chetwynd.

The company extended a reduction in operating capacity at sawmills across Western Canada.



Canfor mills across the region started operating at 80 percent capacity following an announcement in March.

"The global supply challenges are continuing to significantly limit our ability to transport products to our customers and our inventory levels remain very high. We are working to bring our inventory levels back into balance by reducing our production, while also working to meet the needs of our customers," said Don Kayne, President and CEO of Canfor in a statement.

Canfor said the operation reduction is expected to last until after rotating downtime in July and August. The company is planning to complete maintenance during the two weeks of downtime at sawmills across Western Canada.

Why does helium change the sound of your voice?

Have you ever inhaled helium from a balloon? If so, you may have noticed that your voice becomes higher than usual. This is a funny and intriguing side effect. Here's why it happens.

Your vocal cords vibrate when you speak or sing, much like the strings on a guitar. How fast the air passes through your vocal cords determines the pitch of your voice. Slow-moving air makes low-pitched sounds, while fast-moving air makes high-pitched sounds.

Helium is lighter than air. Therefore, when you inhale helium, it travels much more quickly across your vocal cords than oxygen, making your voice sound higher than normal.

Be careful

Though it's fun to alter the pitch of your voice by inhaling helium, don't overdo it. If you inhale too much,

you could deprive your body of oxygen and faint. It's perfectly safe to inhale small quantities of helium, but doing so repeatedly can have dangerous consequences.

Fresh spring rolls

These homemade spring rolls are so delicious, you'll want to make them for every occasion this summer.

- 4 sheets rice paper
- 8 mint leaves
- 4 iceberg lettuce leaves
- 1/2 cup cilantro
- 1/2 cup basil leaves
- 1 cup rice vermicelli cooked and cooled
- 1/2 cup carrots, peeled and julienned
- 1/2 cup cucumbers, julienned
- 8 shrimp, cooked and peeled
- 1 cup ponzu sauce
- 1 cup fish sauce
- 1 lime, guartered

Directions

- Fill a large bowl with warm water. Soak 1 sheet of rice paper in the water for about 20 seconds, or until it's soft. Place the sheet on a clean work surface.
- Layer the following ingredients on the sheet, in this order: 2 mint leaves, 1 lettuce leaf, 1/4 of the cilantro, basil, rice vermicelli, carrots and cucumbers, and 2 shrimp.
- Gently fold the lower edge of the rice paper over the filling, and roll it upward until the filling is completely wrapped. Make sure to gently squeeze the ingredients together, and fold in the sides of the rice paper when it's wrapped halfway.
- Repeat steps 1 to 3 for the remaining rolls. Refrigerate the rolls for 15 minutes before serving them with ponzu and fish sauce. Garnish with lime wedges.

This recipe is versatile and can be adapted to almost any taste. Replace the shrimp with grilled chicken or tofu, for example. If you want to add more veggies, consider including slices of red pepper or purple cabbage.

Morse code basics

Before telephone and satellite communication was invented, Morse code was used to quickly transmit messages over long distances. For example, ships often used Morse code to send distress signals. Additionally, in the past, if you wanted to tell your family when your train would arrive at the station, you could send them a letter in Morse code.

WHAT'S MORSE CODE?

Morse code was invented by Samuel Morse and is a means of communication that uses long and short signals to transmit messages. Morse code is often sent using sound or light signals. It can also be written. For example, short signals are repre-

sented as dots and long signals as dashes:

- A = •=
- E = •
- R = .--
- T = -



Therefore, to communicate the letter A in Morse code, you must transmit a short sound followed by a long sound. Each letter of the alphabet has its own code, so you can easily spell words and phrases using the right combination of signals.

It's a bit complicated, isn't it? Fortunately, today you can simply text, email or phone your friends. However, Morse code is still used in military emergencies.
